SCHOOL CALENDAR CHANGE - MONDAY, APRIL 8 NOW A HALF DAY

This memo is to alert everyone to a change in our school calendar.

We will be having an 11:30AM release on April 8, 2024. Upwards of 200,000 people are expected to descend upon Burlington on that day in order to view the solar eclipse. The partial eclipse starts at 2:14PM and reaches totality at 3:26PM. This is a fascinating natural event and presents a wonderful educational opportunity. We will be learning and talking about it in science classes as the day approaches. However, we are in agreement with many local schools that the event also poses very real logistical, traffic, and safety concerns, and we believe an early dismissal is the most prudent course of action.

Mr. Pendergrass ordered safety glasses for this special event months ago, and we will be distributing them to each student on April 8th. Mr. P also prepared some materials/videos/etc. for you to view as a family as you take in this unique event (see the attached doc from Mr. P).
