SPRING SPORTS UPDATE

Just a reminder that our Spring sports season is here. Below are some reminders about the start dates for each of the sports. If you have a student interested in joining one of these sports or if you have questions please contact Mrs. Donlon at mdonlon@materchristischool.net.

Volleyball - The season has begun. The cutoff date to join the team is Wednesday, March 13. Season ends before most of the other Spring sports begin. Please notify Mrs. Donlon if your 5-8th grader has not already joined but is interested in playing volleyball on our co-ed teams.

Girls on the Run - The roster is full and the first practice is Monday, March 18th.

Mini Miler Club - running club for boys and girls in 1st-4th grade. The weekly running group will meet on Fridays (3:00-4:00) beginning April 5th.

Boys Lacrosse (3rd and 4th graders only) - Practices will begin on Monday, March 25th.

Girls Lacrosse Learn-to-Play Program - For beginning girls lacrosse players in grades 3 and up. Practices will be on Wednesdays beginning April 10th

Girls Lacrosse Middle School Team - Open to 5th -8th grade girls. Practices will be on Tuesdays and Fridays beginning April 16.

Baseball - Our (5th-8th grade) boys will join the Christ the King team. I am still waiting to hear details about when the practices will begin.

Track and Field - Open to 5th-8th graders. Practices will primarily be on Monday, Wednesday, and Fridays beginning April 3rd.

Our coaches are aware that many students who will be participating in the play are likely to have conflicts between sports practices and play rehearsals (up through April 12th). We have been working closely with Mrs. Farley and Ms. King to do our best to minimize conflicts as much as possible because we want students to have the opportunities to participate in both. However, there will inevitably be conflicts and we ask that all athletes recognize and honor their commitments to both. Coaches will understand if you miss a practice, game, or match occasionally to honor your play commitments.

Finally, just a reminder that in order to run our sports programs we do have some expenses. Therefore, there is an athlete participation fee for most sports. We ask that you submit payment for the participation fee no later than the Friday of the second week of the season. Any questions, please contact Mrs. Donlon.
