SCHOOL FORMS ARE DUE

All school forms are due by Monday, August 26, before school begins. Forms were emailed to parents and guardians via the MCS online forms portal. If you did not receive the emails, please notify Kendra Geeslin at kgeeslin@materchristischool.net.

Until all forms are received, your student will not have access to chrome books or technology at school, and a hold will be placed on the student's report card.

PICKUP/DROPOFF TRAFFIC FLOW AND PARKING

DROP-OFF:

- 1. Students in all grades are expected to arrive no earlier than 7:40. Students in grades 1-3 wait outside the elementary building until 7:50, and are then called by grade to their homerooms.
- 2. Please do not use the convent driveway (i.e. the entrance to which is at the end of Loomis Street) at all!
- 3. Elementary families can drop off in front of the elementary building, using the horseshoe driveway OR park in the lot behind the elementary and walk to the front entrance.
- 4. Intermediate and middle school families enter the main driveway and drop their children off along the sidewalk in front of the middle school building.

PICK-UP:

1. <u>Dismissal times:</u>

PS-3rd -- 2:50

4th-5th -- 2:55

6th-8th -- 3:00

- 2. Your student(s) is in the middle school building ONLY -- ENTER the ONE-WAY convent driveway at the Mansfield Ave/Loomis St. intersection. Proceed around the convent and the middle school, which will lead you to the driveway between the schools. Pick up your student(s) along the sidewalk between the schools ONLY. DO NOT pick up student(s) behind the school/convent. DO NOT park or idle behind the school/convent. If your student(s) is not ready to be picked up when you pass between the schools, please go around again (akin to the airport).
- 3. You have students in both buildings -- Enter our normal driveway between the buildings. Park in the lot behind the elementary. Walk to meet your elementary student outside the elementary building, and then meet your older student at the crosswalk. Walk to your car, and exit out the driveway between the buildings, as normal. DO NOT go [the wrong way] around the convent/middle school.
- 4. <u>Your student(s) is in the elementary building ONLY</u> -- Use the horseshoe driveway in front of the elementary building, as normal, and exit out the driveway as normal.

IMPORTANT SAFETY REMINDER:

1. DO NOT park on Mansfield Avenue, and DO NOT have your student(s) cross Mansfield Avenue at any point to meet you or get in your car on Mansfield Avenue. This is a MAJOR safety issue.

UNIFORMS

Students must arrive on the first day of school in uniform. Please refer to the family handbook for specific guidelines and policies. Warm weather options are allowed until October 15.

If you are in need of any particular uniform option, you may visit the MCS uniform closet, located in the elementary school, to see what may be available.

IMPORTANT UPDATE REGARDING SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS AND CHAPERONES

There are several opportunities during the year to volunteer or chaperone field trips for your child's class. The Diocese and Mater Christi School require volunteers and chaperones to complete full background checks before the event. This includes completing a background check authorization form, fingerprinting, and taking a short online child safety

training (VIRTUS). The Diocese requires strict adherence to the policy and MCS will have to decline parents that have not completed ALL background steps BEFORE the field trip date.

If planning on being a volunteer or chaperone this school year, please contact Kate Lafferty klafferty@materchristischool.net to start the background check process (fingerprints can take up to a month). Several of the younger grades (K-3) have fall field trips, so now is a good time to start.
