TABLE OF REMEMBRANCE

In the Catholic tradition, November is a month to remember and pray for loved ones who have journeyed home to their eternal rest. November begins with the Solemnity of All Saints on November 1st and the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed on November 2nd.

On the Solemnity of All Saints we are reminded of a "universal call of holiness," and are encouraged to strive towards holiness in our own unique way. On this day, we remember and pray for deceased loved ones who, while not officially canonized by the Church, are indeed saints whose witness has blessed and enriched our lives. On the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, we are encouraged to pray for all loved ones who have died, trusting in God's unconditional love and mercy.

We would like to extend an invitation to our community as we honor and pray for our loved ones who have journeyed home to God. A "Table of Remembrance" will be set up in the Chapel of the Sacred Heart from Friday, November 1st to Tuesday, November 26th (the day before the Thanksgiving break) and we invite students and families to bring in a framed photo or photos of deceased family members and friends for the Table of Remembrance. Please ensure the photo is labeled on the back of the frame with your family name and child's homeroom so that we can be sure to return these sacred and cherished pictures to you.

All those interested in participating in this annual tradition are welcome to bring photos to our liturgy on November 1st. We will place the photos of your loved ones on the Table of Remembrance where they will remain for our communal celebration of the Eucharist on All Saints Day, and throughout a 25 day period as we hold these beloved family members in prayer each morning.

If your family is interested in participating in this meaningful community event, your children may bring your photos to school on Friday, November 1st, or any day throughout our observance of this tradition. Homeroom teachers will ensure that your photos get to me to be placed on the "Table of Remembrance." Thank you for participating in this beloved tradition.
