2025-2026 PTO LEADERSHIP POSITIONS

The MCS PTO is looking for volunteers for next year's PTO leadership! Being part of the PTO is a fun and enriching way to participate in the culture and community at MCS. Here are the open positions for the 2025-26 school year. All of these positions are a 2 year commitment.

Vice President(s): This role supports the PTO president(s) in executing plans for monthly PTO events. They help coordinate volunteers for activities and collaborate on planning events. On top of monthly, one-hour PTO meetings this position may attend follow up meetings with PTO leadership. This role can be shared by 2 people. The vice president(s) will become president(s) in their second year.

Secretary: This role handles all note taking at PTO meetings and handles paperwork within the PTO drive including tasks like submitting event approval forms and fine tuning SignUp genius forms.

Room Parent Coordinator: This is a recently added position that works primarily through email. The purpose of this position is to be the point person for all room parent volunteers. They work with PTO to make sure each class has a room parent and helps the room parents know the various todos throughout the school year.

NEW THIS YEAR

PTO Publicity Coordinator: This is a new role for the 2025-26 school year as we have identified a need for a point person who can keep their focus on how PTO meetings and events are promoted and advertised to the school community. Their role would include working with school administrators to keep the PTO social media and website up to date. They would also handle all communications with the larger MCS community. This role can also be primarily online if needed.

In all of these roles you will have access to the PTO drive in which there are examples of all forms and notes about all events. It is an incredible resource to new PTO leaders. These new positions will work closely with Meghan Forsyth and Nicole Farley who will move into being PTO presidents next year.

It is important to remember that all PTO positions are volunteer positions. The various roles require different levels of participation, however, the whole team works together to have success. We support each other and fill in for each other should one person need it. The roles are not rigid and we try to lean into people's strengths.
