

Intermediate School Multiplication Boot Camp Intermediate: Entering Grade 4 and Grade 5 Summer 2025

Why:

Summer Multiplication Boot Camp is designed to support new and current students who need **extra review** and **practice** with previously taught multiplication facts. This camp will provide students with an understanding of number sense through multiplication fluency.

Being multiplicatively fluent is essential for students entering fourth and fifth grade.

Math fact fluency is the ability to recall addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division of math facts through conceptual learning, fact strategies, and memorization.

Summer Math Option

Session A - August 18th- 21st from 12:00pm-2:00pm (\$300)- 4 days (NO Friday session.)

A five day (1 ½ hours per day) program focusing on reviewing previously taught multiplication facts. Multiplicative fluency is key to most math concepts taught in fourth grade. Each session will include a combination of direct instruction and classroom practice presented in an array of ways to reach all kinesthetic, auditory, visual, and social learners. A light snack will be provided. Students will leave with games and tools to help them on their intermediate math journey.

Students will attend sessions in person at Mater Christi in small groups. *(Middle School Building)* (maximum of 12 students per session)
