Dates: June 22–26, 2026 (Camp 1), June 29–July 3, 2026 (Camp 2)

Raiding Mater Christi School's Makerspace and Art Lab, campers will explore a variety of media, as well as a range of artistic styles. They will build, sculpt, draw, paint...the skies the limit. Your homes will be filled with Museum gallery worthy pieces, taught by two art teachers with experience teaching over 100 summer camps.
