Registration Fee Update

The registration fee of \$300.00 for the 2026/2027 school year is due by February 18. For those who make automatic ACH payments through FACTS, your registration fee will be transacted on February 18. For those not on automatic ACH, your payment is due to the front office by February 18. The registration fee will increase to \$350.00 on February 19.

Tuition Academic 2026-2027

Full-time Preschool & Pre-kindergarten (5Days/week): \$13,530

Part-time Preschool & Pre-kindergarten (4 days/week or less, half or full days): \$11,890

Elementary & Intermediate (Kindergarten – Grade 5): \$14,600

Middle School (Grades 6-8): \$15,600

Tuition Assistance

Please note the following dates to apply for tuition assistance. We appreciate your timeliness. Tuition assistance applications will be accepted in FACTS starting January 26. You do not need to have completed tax documents for 2025. Families may provide estimates of AGI which will be confirmed when tax documents for 2025 are available and uploaded into FACTS. Mater Christi reserves the right to adjust tuition assistance awards based on actual 2025 tax documents.

The window for tuition assistance closes for current families on April 15 – after that date, there will not be funds available for tuition assistance for current families.

Please note that your application in FACTS must be complete in order to be reviewed by the tuition assistance committee. We do not review partial submissions.

TUITION PAYMENT POLICY 2026-2027

Tuition Payments

Tuition may be made in one, two, ten or twelve installments. Tuition is paid through the FACTS Management Company. All tuition payments are paid through FACTS Tuition Management. Your selected payment plan in FACTS will renew annually. For the academic year 2026-2027, registration fees will be charged through FACTS.

Early Withdrawal Penalties

Withdrawal refers to a student's last day of attendance at Mater Christi School. For example, if a student withdraws on October 15, the family is responsible for the November and December tuition, regardless of the date of notification.

- Families will be charged a fee equal to one (1) month's tuition for withdrawal after July 1, but prior to July 31.
- Families will be charged a fee equal to two (2) month's tuition for withdrawal after August 1.
- For a student who is withdrawn during the school year, tuition is calculated for the portion of time attended, plus a fee equal to two (2) month's tuition.
- The respective fee is applicable even if the student does not start the school year.

The Board of Trustees must make educated budget decisions early in the winter based on a projected number of families expected to attend Mater Christi. Staffing needs are met and contracts signed, thus cementing Mater Christi's financial obligations for the new school year. Although students may withdraw, the school's financial obligations to staff remain the same for the academic year.

Non-Payment of Tuition

Non-payment of tuition will result in disenrollment from Mater Christi School. No report card will be issued at the end of the school year to families that have outstanding tuition balances.

Families Not Returning

Families not returning to Mater Christi School for the 2026-2027 school year must provide written notification to the President/Head of School with their intent to withdraw and effective withdrawal date.
