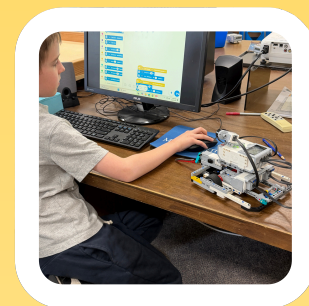
Mud Masters: Clay Camp

Grades: Entering 3rd–5th grade. **Enrollment Max:** 15 per camp

Does your child enjoy creative, hands-on art? Do they like to get a little messy? Artists will be able to explore the endless possibilities clay has to offer. Campers will experiment with different methods of clay building such as, pinch, coil, and slab, as well as how to use colorful underglaze techniques to glaze our creations. Pieces will be fired, carefully wrapped, and available for pick up the week of July 13–17, 2026.

With the MCS computer labs and Makerspace as our home base, campers will explore fundamental STEAM concepts in a new and exciting way. You will be shocked by what you can achieve with your new coding skills.

Cost: \$400 per student, per camp.

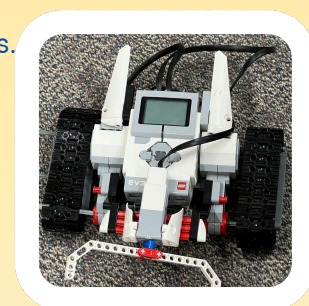
Meet the Instructors:
